Colonel Timothy Fuller received his commission as an Infantry Officer from Michigan State University. His military education includes the Infantry Officer Basic and Advanced Courses, Special Forces Qualification Course, Command and General Staff College and the Army War College. He is a Defense Language Institute graduate of both Turkish and Romanian languages and he earned a Masters of Business Administration specializing in Supply Chain and Financial Management from the W.P. Carey School of Business at Arizona State University.

COL Fuller has led a variety of command and staff positions. He served as an Infantry, Bradley Fighting Vehicle platoon leader, mortar platoon leader, and the Battalion Assistant Operations Officer with the 1-36th Infantry Regiment, 1st Armored Division, Friedberg, Germany. While with the 1-36th Infantry, he deployed twice to Bosnia and Herzegovina in support of IFOR and SFOR. He then served as a Special Forces Operational Detachment Alpha Commander, Company Executive Officer and Battalion Plans Officer with the 10th Special Forces Group (Airborne), Ft Carson, Colorado. While with 10th SFG(A), he deployed once to Kosovo in support of KFOR and twice to Iraq in support of Operation Iraqi Freedom.

COL Fuller joined the Army Acquisition Corps in 2005 and was first assigned to the Project Management Office, Stryker Brigade Combat Team in Warren, Michigan. There he was an Assistant Product Manager for fielding, vehicle Production and retrofit operations. He was later assigned to the Pentagon where he served in the Office of the Assistant Secretary of the Army for Acquisition Logistics and Technology (ASA(ALT)) as a Department of the Army Staff Coordinator, Army Systems Acquisition Review Council (ASARC) Executive Secretary. During this time he deployed to Afghanistan in support of Operation Enduring Freedom (OEF) as the United States Forces Afghanistan, Regional Command East, Acquisition Advisor. COL Fuller was then assigned to Program Executive Office Soldier, as the Product Manager Soldier Maneuver Sensors where he led and managed numerous night vision programs of record. COL Fuller most recently served as the Executive Officer to the ASA(ALT).

COL Fuller's awards and decorations include the Bronze Star Medal with two oak leaf clusters, Meritorious Service Medal with three oak leaf clusters, Army Commendation Medal with two oak leaf clusters, Army Achievement Medal with oak leaf cluster, Valorous Unit Award, Army Superior Unit Award, Special Forces Tab, Ranger Tab, Combat Infantryman Badge, Expert Infantryman Badge, Senior Parachutist Badge, Air Assault Badge, Army Staff Identification Badge and Italian Basic Parachutist Badge.
